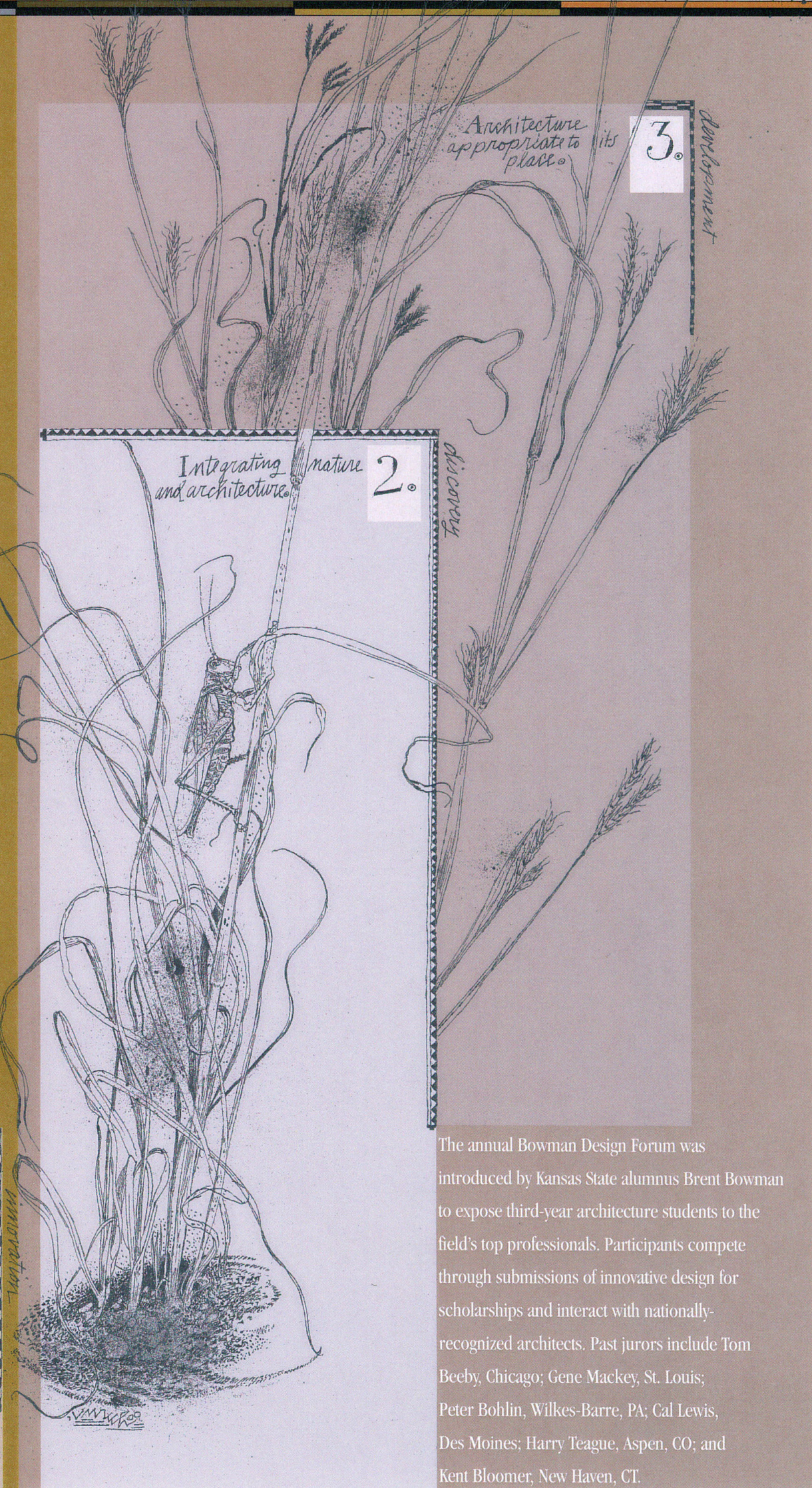
Koning Eizenberg Architecture

Julie Eizenberg is a founding principal of Koning Eizenberg Architecture in Santa Monica, CA, beginning practice in 1981. Focus on providing design excellence with limited financial resources and work on socially-oriented projects has earned the firm national and international esteem.

These comfortable spaces place emphasis on "humanism," where space and architecture are defined by features using the power of suggestion within the building. Community centers, schools, recreation centers, hotels, homes, stores, businesses and affordable housing have benefited from the firm's affordable architecture concept. Additionally, Eizenberg has worked on the Pittsburgh Children's Museum expansion, the Downtown L.A. Standard Hotel, and 5th Street Housing in Santa Monica, California.

KEA recently won two national competitions for their efforts on a children's museum and a school in Chicago. She holds degrees from the University of Melbourne, Australia and UCLA. Eizenberg was also recently appointed to the GSA Design Excellence program as a peer reviewer. Her influence and approach to architecture can also be measured by the number of speaking and teaching engagements around the globe.
