

Marianne McKenna is one of the four founding principals of KPMB, established in 1987. She has spent much of her career devoting herself to the advocation of exceptional design, generating connections of space, form and community through architecture.

McKenna's strength of condition in design has led her to several successful projects and resulted in a Governor General's Award for Architecture, the highest accolade in Canada for superior work. She has led such projects as the McGill University and Genome Quebec Innovation Centre, Concordia Universities new facilities of Engineering/Computer Science and Engineering/Computer Science and Visual Arts, and Jackson-Triggs Niagara Estate Winery. McKenna's strategic leadership has also directed historical facilities, concert halls and other performing arts venues.

The Swarthmore College and Yale University graduate has taught at McGill University's Faculty of Architecture, L'Université de Montréal and the University of Toronto's Faculty of Architecture. She has also served as critic and guest lecturer at Yale University and Carleton, among others




