In his work as an architect and a member of the community, Tim draws on passionately held values, which he conveys both by example and through the ideals, policies and practices he has instilled at Neumann Monson. As a leader, he strives to maintain a graceful balance of compassion and a tenacious drive towards excellence.

After earning his B. Arch. with distinction in 1994, he joined the firm full-time. Licensed in 1998, he became a principal and studio leader in 2000. Among Tim's projects were the firm's first to earn AIA Iowa and AIA Central States Region recognitions.

While an emerging professional, Tim led several projects to sustainable firsts in Iowa, while his work with a local developer introduced urban living and renewed vibrancy to Iowa City. These contributions, along with his efforts as Editor-in-Chief of *Iowa Architecture Magazine*, led to Tim's receipt of the AIA National Young Architect Award in 2008 and became the firm's Vice President.

Heading the firm's operations, Tim led the 35-year old firm's transformation, improving design quality, staff engagements and client satisfaction. In 2018, Tim became Neumann Monson's President.

Tim's balance of compassion and drive toward excellence has been echoed in his policies and practices that build empathy and alignment. Neumann Monson has emerged as a leader in design and environmental stewardship, a national leader in both client and employee stewardship and a community leader with expanding positive impact.




Since 2012 Nick has led Neumann Monson's Design Quality Group to facilitate concept discussion and emphasize design rigor. The result has been a keen focus on design excellence for himself and his colleagues. His own projects have garnered state and regional honors.


In his community Nick is allied with the Downtown District, shaping policy and now leading the organization as President. His efforts are aimed at elevating conversations in the business and arts community.

As an Assistant Professor of Practice at Iowa State University he recently co-taught a comprehensive design studio with student projects located in New Orleans and Davenport, Iowa along the Mississippi River.

Nick's efforts and impact culminated in the AIA Iowa's Young Architect in 2018 and the National AIA Young Architects Award in 2020.
